Parent Satisfaction Questionnaire

Thank you to everyone who completed a survey. We were delighted with the responses received!

100% of parents believe that they have made the right choice of childcare and would recommend us to other parents.

100% of parents either agree or strongly agree that they have good relationships with staff and that staff are approachable.

100% of parents agree or strongly agree that the club communicates information well.

97% of parents feel that the service is reflected in the fees.

100% of parents feel that the club offers a good range of play opportunities and activities.

94% of parents are happy with the food we provide.

62% of parents believe that the best thing about Fusion is our team, whilst 45% think that our range of activities that we offer are the best.

5% of you asked of we could do homework with your children. We do offer homework help and have a homework table/area. However, children come to Fusion after having a long day at school and therefore want to release some energy and enjoy the stimulating play environment we provide. We will of course support your child if they want to but unfortunately we cannot insist they do.
