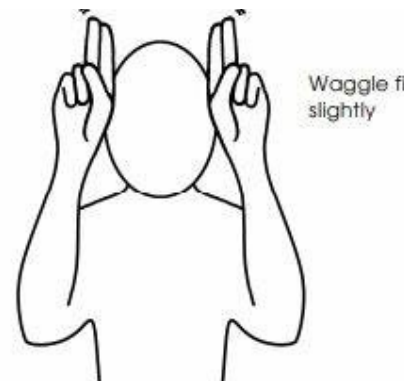

This Week the sign of the week is 'Rabbit - The animal for Lunar New Year. Can you copy this at home?

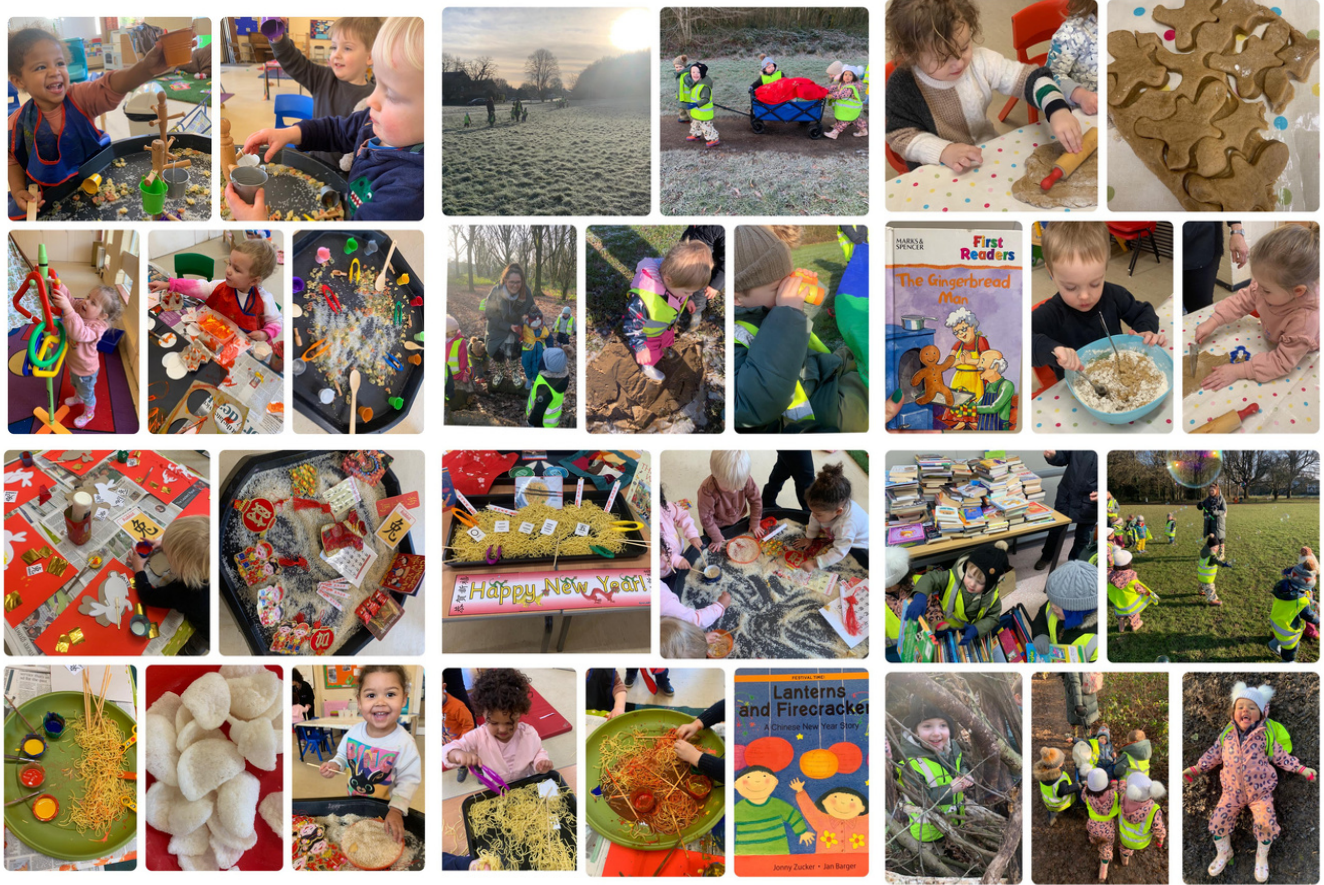

- Monday 30th January 2023: Applications for September 2023 Nursery places open
- Monday 6th March 2023: The first round of applications for September 2023 Nursery places close
- Monday 20th March 2023: Schools will write to parents offering a place
- Monday 27th March 2023: Parents must accept or decline a place by this date
