Can you make an Obstacle Course at home? Obstacle courses promote: physical activity, which is essential for physical development and overall health gross motor skill development, children can develop their balance, coordination, core strength, head movement, shoulder stabilisation problem-solving and decision-making skills, as they navigate through the obstacles, which helps to develop their cognitive abilities.

spatial awareness and perception, as children judge distances and angles to navigate through each obstacle social and emotional development, obstacle courses encourage teamwork, communication, and cooperation as children may need to wait and work together

motivation and engagement as children enjoy the challenge and excitement of navigating through each obstacle, which increases their motivation and engagement in the learning process.
