You should have received an update in the last week regarding your child's development at Pre-School and how you can support at home. Please feel free to feedback and Key Workers are always available.

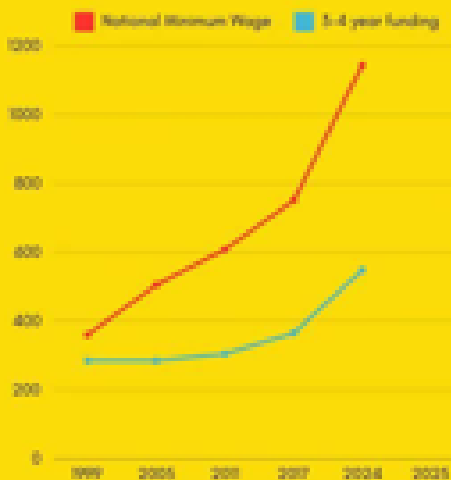
