Loose Parts:

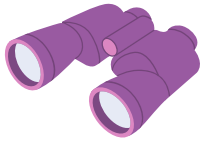
Examples of loose parts include:

- Natural materials: sticks, stones, shells, pinecones, leaves
- Recycled materials: cardboard tubes, bottle caps, fabric scraps, boxes
- Household items: baskets, spoons, pegs, buttons, lids
- Construction materials: wooden blocks, crates, PVC pipes, tyres



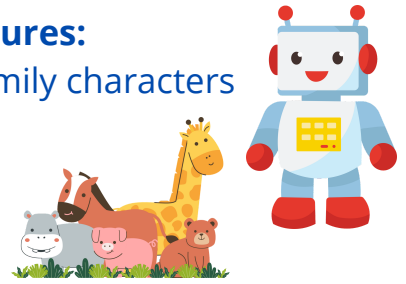
Spy Box:

Why is play so important?

- Builds confidence, resilience and independence.

- Helps children make sense of the world through exploration and discovery.

Our practice is guided by the Playwork Principles, which recognise every child's right to freely chosen, personally directed and intrinsically motivated play. This means children lead their own play while we create safe, stimulating environments that encourage curiosity, challenge and fun.

Inspired by established play theories, we know that children learn best through meaningful, hands-on experiences. Whether they are building dens, exploring outdoors, creating with loose parts, engaging in role play or inventing games with friends, taking part in Mix up week, doing a science experimentt, making slime, every play opportunity supports their development.

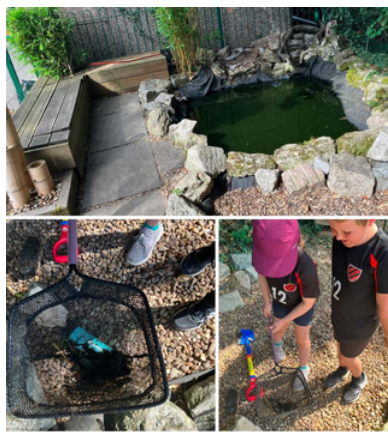
